

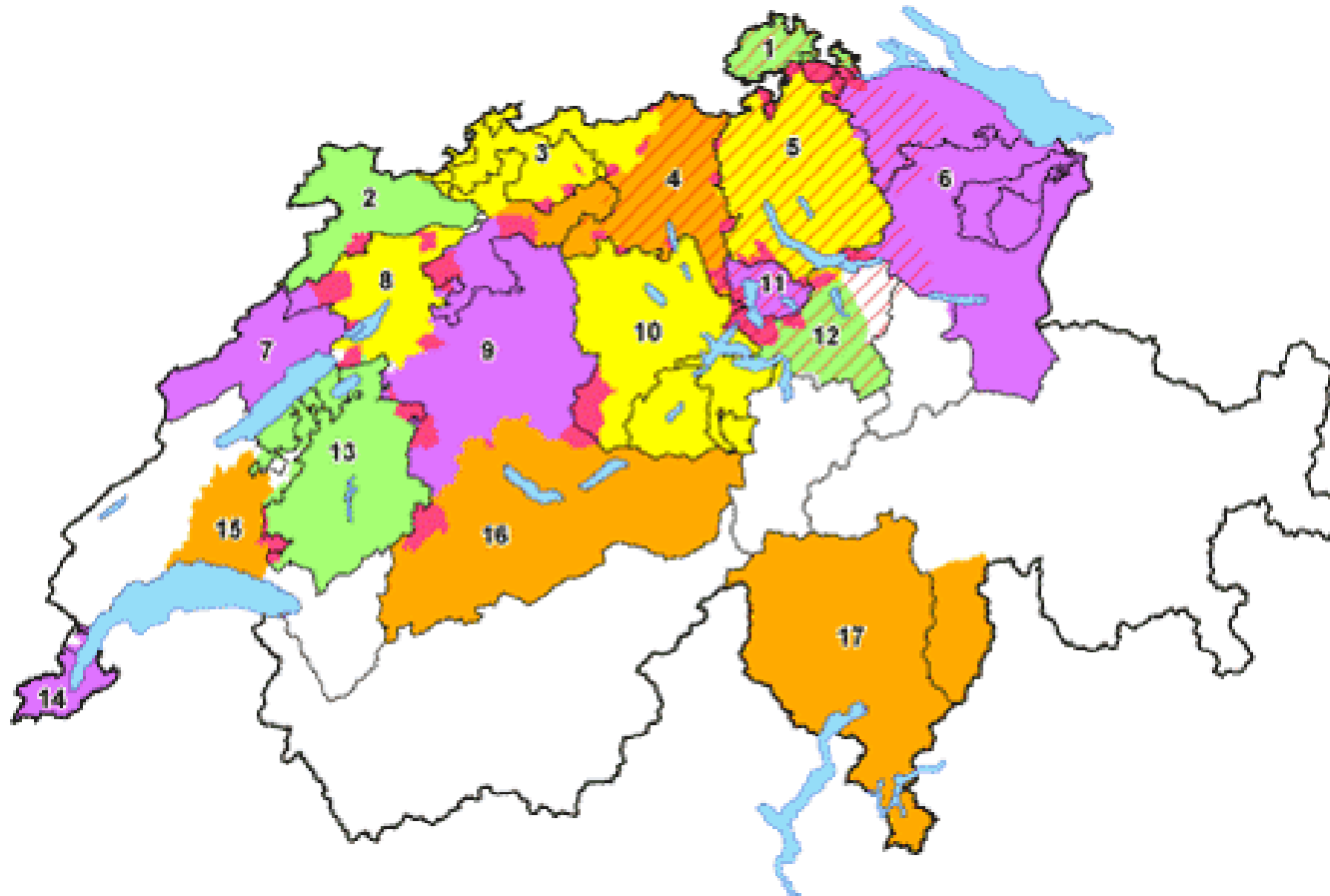

Tariff association for monthly and annual tickets

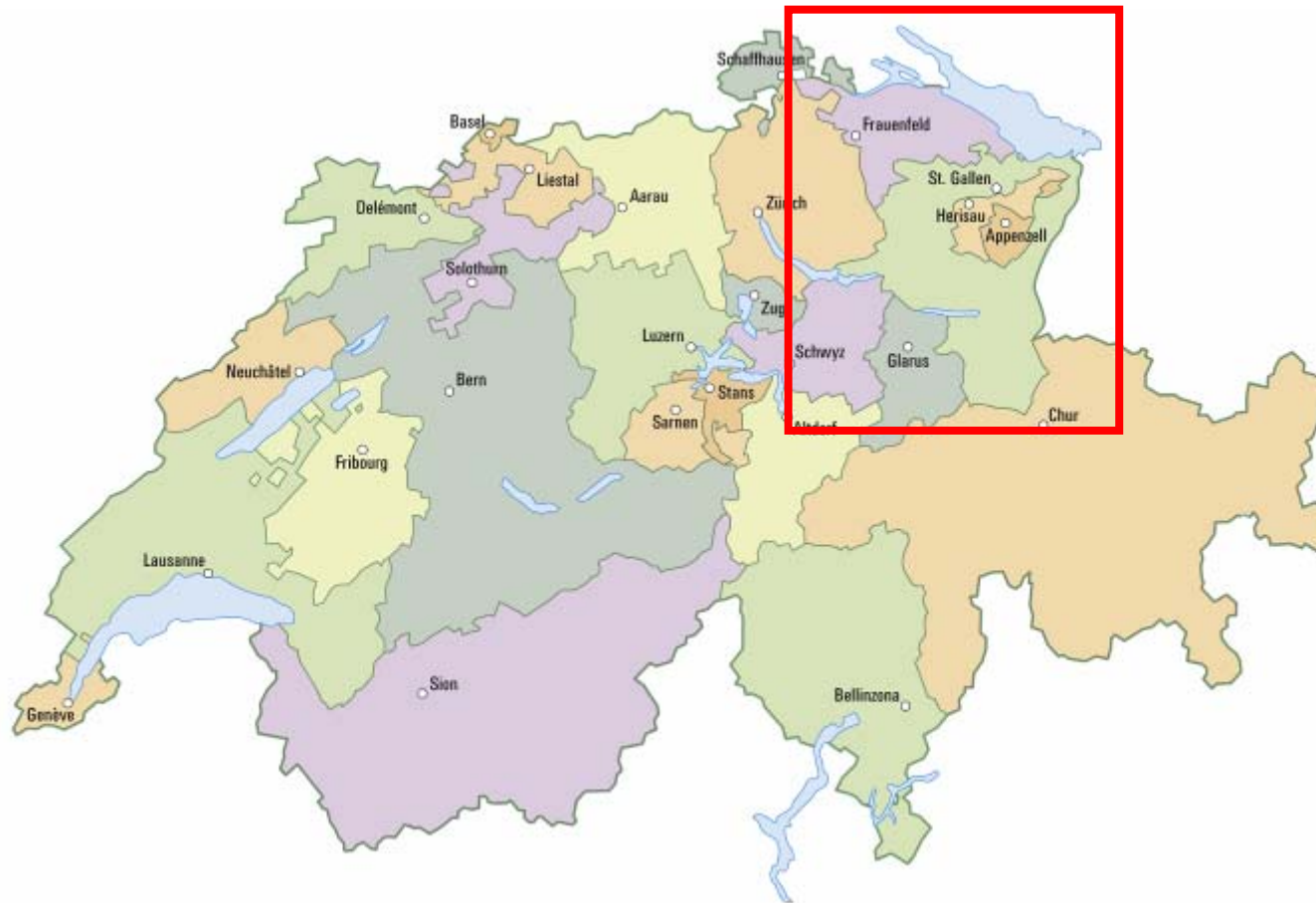
These **features** are valid for regular customers **only** (annual and monthly passes)
